SITE VISIT AGENDA:

1. Application PDR23-0001/ARB23-0006; 12261 Country Squire Lane; (386-05-075) Shao Shuyi & Min Zhao (Applicant) - The applicant is requesting Design Review approval for a new 3,538 square foot single story single-family residence (maximum height 20'2"). One protected tree is proposed for removal. The site is zoned R-1-10,000 with a General Plan Designation of Medium Density Residential (M-10). Application PDR22-0013/ARB22-0063; 20756 Kreisler Court; (366-25-013) Mike Ma (Applicant); Bei Jiang and Kenyu Tojima (Owners) - The applicant is requesting Design Review approval for a new 3,709 square foot two story single-family residence (maximum height 24'-8.5"). No protected trees are proposed for removal. The site is zoned R-1-12,500 with a General Plan Designation of Medium Density Residential (M-12.5). 3. Application PDR22-0005/ARB23-0073; 19900 Douglas Lane; (397-17-065) Warren Tamashiro (Applicant); Lesyle and Al Fazio (Owners) - The applicant is requesting Design Review approval for a 182 square foot first story addition and a 401 square foot second story addition to an existing one-story single-family residence. The project will increase the height of the structure from 21 feet to 26 feet. No trees are proposed for removal.
