1. Traffic Matrix #401- Montalvo Road Parking

Issue: Request by Commissioner Tim Harris to restrict parking on Montalvo Road in between Montalvo Heights Drive and Montalvo Lane due to narrowness of the road preventing emergency vehicles from traveling to that location. This item was first placed on the agenda by the neighbors of Montalvo Lane and heard by the Commission in November 2017. The item was delayed due to the ambiguity of the issue but is now represented by Commissioner Harris since he is a Montalvo Lane resident.
