### **Teleconference/Public Participation Information to Mitigate the Spread of COVID-19**

2. Paint the City

**Recommended Action:**

Receive a report summarizing the Paint the City Program and consider the recommendation from the Paint the City subcommittee to recommend that the City Council approve the following three locations for the next Paint the City cycle: 1) Saratoga Avenue at State Route 85 North; 2) Saratoga Avenue at State Route 85 North; and, 3) Saratoga Avenue at Dagmar. The committee also recommended Saratoga Avenue at Vineyard as a backup option. The Commission may make a motion to recommend City Council approval of the committee's suggested Paint the City locations or move to recommend alternative locations.
