An investigation revealed the suspect pedestrian was under the influence of a controlled substance. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.

1/4	S8	Mail Theft, Theft by Credit Card	Between 12:15 PM on 1/3 and 2:32 PM on 1/4, unknown suspect(s) took a mail package, containing a newly issued credit card, from the front porch of a residence in the 18000 block of Devon Avenue. The suspect(s) then used the credit card to make a fraudulent purchase for a total loss of about \$315.
