1/15	S9	Identity Theft	In October of 2017, the victim received information indicating unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to open a credit card account for an unknown total loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.
1/15	S9	Identity Theft	On 1/9, the victim received information indicating unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to open multiple credit card accounts for an unknown total loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.
1/15	S7	Petty Theft	At 2:06 PM on 1/9, unknown suspect(s) took an empty mail package box from the front porch of a residence in the 13000 block of Myren Drive.
1/15	S9	Injury Collision	Occurred at 8:31 PM at Quito Road and Marshall Lane.
1/16	S4	Vandalism, Attempted Mail Theft	Between 7:00 PM on 1/15 and 8:00 AM on 1/16, unknown suspect(s) attempted to pry open the mailboxes of residences in the 21000 block of Haymeadow Drive, causing damage. The total amount of damage was about \$250.
1/17	S4	Residential Burglary, Resist/Delay Arrest, ARREST	At 7:20 PM, deputies responded to an in-progress burglary call at a residence in the 14000 block of Dorene Court where the suspects entered the residence by breaking a window. Upon deputies' arrival, one suspect immediately fled the scene in the getaway vehicle, while two others fled the scene on foot. One suspect was apprehended, arrested and booked into Main Jail a short time later, while detectives assigned to the case are following-up on leads for arrest of the two outstanding suspects. It is unknown what, if anything, was taken from the home.
1/18	S4	Vandalism	Between 7:00 PM on 1/16 and 9:00 AM on 1/18, unknown suspect(s) tampered with the door and lock of a residential mailbox in the 21000 block of Haymeadow Drive. The total amount of damage is unknown.
1/18	S2	Injury Collision	Occurred at 8:59 AM at Cumberland Drive and Cox Avenue.
1/19	S1	Non-Injury Collision	Occurred at 2:19 PM at Paramount Court and Pierce Road.
1/19	S3	Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, Possession of Misappropriated Property and Slingshot, Resist Arrest ARREST	At 3:40 PM, deputies made contact with a pedestrian at Lyle Drive and Prospect Road for standing in the roadway. An investigation revealed the suspect was under the influence of an unknown controlled substance, in addition to being in possession of a slingshot and misappropriated property, all offenses in violation of the suspect's probation. The suspect was arrested, after initially resisting, and booked into Main Jail.
1/21	S6	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 7:35 AM at Horseshoe Drive and Highway 9.
