1/23	S4	Mail Theft, Identity Theft	Between 1/20 and 1/23, unknown suspect(s) took mail from the mailbox of a residence in the 14000 block of Springer Avenue and used the victim's personal information to apply for credit cards for an unknown total loss.
1/24	S3	Injury Collision	Occurred at 6:00 PM at Prospect Road and Scully Avenue.
1/25	S4	Theft by False Pretenses	On 1/25, unknown suspect(s) telephoned the victim claiming to be the victim's grandson, in jail out-of-state and in need of money. The victim wired money to an unknown bank account for a total loss of about \$10,000 before learning it was a scam. The victim lives in Saratoga.
1/26	S4	Residential Burglary	At 10:20 AM, deputies responded to an in-progress burglary call at a residence in the 21000 block of Saratoga Heights Drive, where the suspect(s) entered the home by breaking a rear window. The suspect(s) ransacked the home, taking a camera and laptop, before being confronted by the victim homeowner and fleeing the scene. An extensive search of the nearby areas was conducted, whereby deputies found the stolen property. The suspect(s) are unknown and at large.
1/26	S1	Injury Collision	Occurred at 6:07 PM at Saratoga Sunnyvale Road and Cox Avenue.
1/28	S2	Residential Burglary	Between 4:12 AM and 4:30 AM, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 19000 block of Scotland Drive by breaking the front glass door. It is unknown if anything was taken from the residence.
1/28	S3	Recovered Stolen Vehicle	At 9:56 AM, deputies recovered a vehicle, previously stolen from San Jose, in the 12000 block of Woodside Drive. The suspect(s) are unknown and at large.
1/28	S4	Injury Collision	Occurred at 2:53 PM at Mt. Eden Road and Damon Lane.
1/28	S3	DUI, Suspended DL, Possession/Transportation of a Controlled Substance for Sales, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Open Container ARREST	At 9:30 PM, deputies stopped a motorist at Prospect Road and S. Blaney Avenue for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect driver was driving under the influence of drugs and did not have a valid driver's license, in violation of the suspect's probation. Further investigation revealed there was an open container in the vehicle and the suspect passenger was in possession of methamphetamine for sales and related drug paraphernalia. Both suspects were arrested and booked into Main Jail.
