2/12	S8	DUI ARREST	At 2:30 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Highway 85 and Saratoga Avenue for a traffic violation. An investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect driver for driving under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was booked into Main Jail.
2/12	S6	Residential Burglary	Between 6:00 PM and 7:30 PM, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 14000 block of Montalvo Road by breaking a window and took jewelry for a total loss of about \$21,000.
2/13	S6	Residential Burglary	At 12:00 AM, unknown suspect(s) entered the garage of a residence in the 19000 block of Harleigh Drive through an open garage door. The suspect(s) entered two unlocked vehicles inside the garage and took a purse and a wallet for an unknown total loss.
2/13	S2	Residential Burglary	Between 12:00 AM and 12:15 AM, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 19000 block of Merrbrook Drive by kicking in doors. A portion of the home was ransacked, but it is unknown if anything was taken from the residence.

An investigation revealed the suspect was in possession of Methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. The suspect was cited and released.

2/15	S5	False Registration Tabs, Suspended DL, No Proof of Insurance ARREST	At 4:34 PM, deputies stopped a motorist at Saratoga Los Gatos Road and Oak Street for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect affixed fraudulent registration tabs to the vehicle, and was driving with a suspended driver's license, without proof of insurance. The suspect was cited and released.
2/16	S6	Attempted Residential Burglary, Petty Theft, Residential Burglary, Possession of Stolen Property, Stolen Vehicles ARREST	Between 8:25 AM and 12:00 PM, the suspects first attempted to enter a residence in the 20000 block of Brookwood Lane, after kicking in a side gate and entering the backyard, but did not gain entry to the residence. The suspects did, however, take a mail package from the front porch of the residence. The suspects then entered a residence in the 20000 block of La Paloma Avenue by removing a screen and opening an unlocked sliding window. The suspects took assorted electronics and jewelry, some of which was recovered after the suspects were stopped in San Jose in a vehicle just stolen during the burglary of a residence in the 13000 block of Verde Vista Court, where the suspects entered the residence by kicking in a rear door and took about \$2,000 in cash, in addition to the victim's vehicle. Three suspects were arrested and booked into Juvenile Hall.
