2/26	S4	Mail Theft, Identity Theft	Between 1/1 and 2/25, unknown suspect(s) took mail from the mailbox of a residence in the 20000 block of Saratoga Hills Road and subsequently used the victim's personal information, likely taken from the mail, to open a credit account for an unknown total loss.
2/26	S9	Vandalism	Between 8:00 AM on 1/15 and 5:00 PM on 1/20, unknown suspect(s) poured water into the diesel fuel tank of the victim's truck while parked at a construction work site in the 14000 block of Evans Lane. The total amount of damage was about \$13,000.
2/26	S2	Identity Theft	Between 2/21 and 2/22, unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information and hacked the victim's online retailer account and changed the shipping address. The victim made a purchase through the account and the item was shipped to unknown suspect(s) for a total loss of about \$73. The victim lives in Saratoga.
2/26	S3	Reckless Evading, Assault on a Peace Officer, Possession of Stolen Vehicle and Drug Paraphernalia, Unlicensed Driver, Resisting Arrest ARREST	At 12:38 AM, deputies attempted to stop a motorist in the area of Prospect Road and Lawrence Expressway for a traffic violation, but the suspect driver failed to yield, and recklessly evaded. At one point the suspect vehicle stopped, and drove at a deputy, ramming the deputy's patrol vehicle. The suspect vehicle eventually crashed into three parked cars, whereupon the suspect fled on foot, but was ultimately detained by deputies. An investigation revealed the suspect was driving a vehicle stolen during the commission of a commercial burglary, without a valid driver's license, and was in possession of drug paraphernalia. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
2/26	S8	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 10:13 AM at Saratoga Avenue and Blackford Avenue.
2/26	S1	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 7:20 PM at Saratoga Sunnyvale Road and Oak Creek Lane.
2/27	S2	Commercial Burglary	Between 5:00 PM on 2/26 and 8:30 AM on 2/27, unknown suspect(s) broke the lockbox attached to the front door of a new business under construction, Root Cause Medical Clinic on Blauer Drive, and used the key from the lockbox to unlock and enter the business. The suspect(s) took appliances and office equipment for an unknown total loss.
2/27	S2	Injury Collision	Occurred at 7:05 PM at Cox Avenue and Saratoga Creek Drive.
3/1	S7	Non-Injury Collision	Occurred at 11:00 AM at Allendale Avenue and Fruitvale Avenue.
3/1	S3	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 4:35 PM at Cox Avenue and Village Drive.
3/4	S9	Identity Theft	Between 3/3 and 3/4, unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to open a credit account with an online retailer and made fraudulent purchases totaling about \$3,800. The victim lives in Saratoga.

3/4	S2	Vehicle Burglary, Possession of Stolen Property, Burglary Tools, Controlled Substance and Drug Paraphernalia, Unlawful Use of Access Card, Suspended DL, False Information to Officer ARREST	At 2:42 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Highway 85 and Saratoga Avenue for traffic violations. An investigation revealed the suspect driver and suspect occupant had committed a vehicle burglary and were in possession of stolen property, including a wallet and credit cards, burglary tools, Methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. Further investigation revealed the suspect driver was driving with a suspended driver's license and the suspect occupant provided false identifying information to deputies to avoid detection of outstanding warrants. Both suspects were in violation of probation, arrested and booked into Main Jail.
3/4	S5	Reckless Evading, Kidnapping, False Imprisonment, Non-Injury Collision, Battery on Police Canine, Resist Arrest, Unlicensed Driver, Driving Under the Influence of Drugs ARREST	At 1:05 PM, deputies attempted to stop a motorist near Big Basin Way and 3 <sup>rd</sup> Street for traffic violations, but the suspect driver failed to yield and recklessly evaded while there was a passenger in the vehicle asking to stop and be let out. The vehicle did not stop until first crashing into a retaining wall, then a curb in the 20000 block of Sunset Drive. The suspect refused to exit the vehicle, and a police canine was utilized, with the suspect injuring the dog. An investigation revealed the suspect was driving under the influence of drugs, without a driver's license. The suspect was medically treated, arrested and booked into Main Jail.
