3/5	S3	Grand Theft	Between 8:00 PM and 8:30 PM on 2/22, unknown suspect(s), who were given brief access to the residence in the 12000 block of Mellowood Drive to provide care for the victim, took the victim's laptop for a total loss of about \$2,000.
3/5	S8	Grand Theft	Between 9:00 PM on 3/2 and 9:10 AM on 3/3, unknown suspect(s) entered an unlocked vehicle parked in the driveway of a residence in the 18000 block of Bellgrove Circle and took alcohol, a blanket, clothing, garage door openers and sunglasses for a total loss of about \$1,350.

3/6	S4	Commercial Burglary	Between 4:00 PM on 3/5 and 7:30 AM on 3/6, unknown suspect(s) entered a residential construction site in the 13000 block of Vista Regina by using body force to break the plywood covering a window and took assorted tools for a total loss of about \$1,765.
3/6	S6	DUI ARREST	At 1:50 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Saratoga Avenue and Fruitvale Avenue for traffic violations. An investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect driver for driving under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was booked into Main Jail.
3/7	S3	Theft by False Pretenses	On 3/7, unknown suspect(s) e-mailed the victims claiming to be the victims' pastor and solicited money in the form of gift cards under the pretense that the money was for a friend with cancer. The victims complied and provided the gift card numbers via e-mail, only to later learn it was a scam for a total loss of about \$200. The victims live in Saratoga.
3/7	S3	Residential Burglary	At 10:30 AM, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 19000 block of Northampton Drive through an open garage door and fled the scene without taking anything upon seeing someone was home.
3/9	S7	DUI ARREST	At 10:08 PM, deputies stopped a motorist at Cox Avenue and Paseo Presada for a traffic violation. An investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect driver for driving under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was booked into Main Jail.

3/10	S8	Reckless Evading, Possession of Controlled Substances ARREST	At 12:42 AM, deputies attempted to stop a motorist in the area of Saratoga Avenue and Bucknall Road for a traffic violation, but the suspect driver recklessly evaded until coming to a dead end in a cul-de-sac. An investigation revealed the suspect driver was in possession of Cocaine, Marijuana and Xanax without a prescription. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
3/10	S6	Non-Injury Collision	Occurred at 3:15 PM at Saratoga Avenue and Herriman Avenue.
3/10	S3	Reckless Evading, DUI, Transportation and Possession of Controlled Substances for Sales ARREST	At 9:51 PM, deputies were patrolling in the area of De Havilland Drive and Cox Avenue when a known, wanted felon was observed driving with a nonoperational license plate light. Deputies attempted to stop the suspect driver, but the suspect recklessly evaded and did not stop until reaching the suspect's residence in the 12000 block of Scully Avenue. An investigation revealed the suspect was driving under the influence of drugs, was transporting and in possession of Methamphetamine for sales, in addition to possessing drug paraphernalia. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
