3/12	S2	Grand Theft	Between 11/30/17 and 2/11/18, unknown suspect(s) were given access to a residence in the 12000 block of Country Squire to render cleaning services and took jewelry for a total loss of about \$12,065.

The suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to make a fraudulent online purchase for a total loss of about \$75. The victim lives in Saratoga.

Further investigation revealed the suspect passenger was in possession of drug paraphernalia and had outstanding warrants, in violation of the suspect's post release community supervision terms. Both were arrested and booked into Main Jail.
