3/19	S2	Sale of Tobacco to Minor ARREST	At 1:56 PM, a tobacco sales compliance check was conducted at the Stop 'n' Save convenience store on Saratoga Sunnyvale Road whereby the suspect sold a tobacco product to a minor under 21 years old. The suspect was cited and released.
