4/1	S8	Possession of Burglary Tools ARREST	At 12:48 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Saratoga Avenue and Quito Road for a traffic violation. Because the driver was on searchable probation, deputies searched the vehicle and found a manipulated tool consistent with burglary tools, along with marijuana, and a spilled container of alcohol. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
3/31	S9	Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance ARREST	At 9:39 PM, deputies contacted a person in the 14000 block of Fruitvale Lane. An investigation revealed the suspect pedestrian was under the influence of a controlled substance. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
3/31	S9	DUI ARREST	At 4:00 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Quito Road and Pollard Road for a traffic violation. An investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect driver for driving under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was booked into Main Jail.
3/31	S4	Identity Theft	Between 3/28 and 3/30, a known suspect used the victim's personal information to access the victim's debit card accounts to obtain goods and money for a total loss of about \$694. The suspect remains at large. The victim lives in Saratoga.
3/30	S2	DUI ARREST	At 1:30 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Saratoga Sunnyvale Road and Prospect Road for a traffic violation. An investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect driver for driving under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was booked into Main Jail.
3/28	S8	Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, ARREST	At 6:19 PM, deputies stopped a motorist at Saratoga Avenue and Quito Road for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect driver was in possession of drug paraphernalia. The suspect was cited and released.
3/28	S3	Possession of a Controlled Substance for Sales, Felon in Possession of Stun Gun, Possession of Stolen Property ARREST	On 3/27, at 10:44 PM, deputies made contact with (3) adults behind a dumpster at Prospect Road and Lawrence Expressway. An investigation revealed the suspects were smoking marijuana, were in possession of a stun gun, had drugs packaged for sale, and a stolen laptop. One suspect was cited and released, another was released with no charges, and the last suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
3/26	S7	Damage to Electrical/Utility Lines	Between 3/23 and 3/24, unknown suspect(s) attempted to steal valuable metal from a utility pole located in the 13600 block of Quito Road. They caused about \$10,000 in damage. The suspect(s) remain unknown and at large.
3/26	S2	Identity Theft	Between 3/23 and 3/26, an unknown suspect had the victim provide his personal information under fraudulent conditions. The victim was able to stop any monetary loss. The suspect remains unknown and at large. The victim lives in Saratoga.
