4/2	S2	Grand Theft	On 3/28, the victim discovered unknown suspect(s) hacked the victim's frequent flyer travel rewards account and used over 100,000 miles to purchase gift cards for a total loss of about \$3,000. The victim lives in Saratoga.
4/2	S3	Vehicle Tampering	Between 2:00 PM on 3/29 and 12:00 PM on 3/30, unknown suspect(s) punctured the two front tires of a vehicle parked in the 19000 block of Vineyard Lane for a total loss of about \$250.
