4/9	S2	Identity Theft	Between July of 2017 and April of 2018, unknown suspect(s) used the victim's business tax code to make credit card transactions after using the victim's business information to open an unauthorized purchase order account for a total loss of about \$323,000. The victim lives and conducts business in Saratoga.
