4/16	S1	Identity Theft	On 4/9, the victim received information indicating unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to access the victim's bank account and made fraudulent transactions for an unknown total loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.
4/16	S9	Injury Collision	Occurred at 10:16 AM at Fruitvale Avenue and Burgundy Way.
4/16	S8	Petty Theft	Between 11:00 AM and 11:20 AM, unknown suspect(s) took skin and beauty products meant for a sales meeting that were left unattended on a table outside of Starbucks on Cox Avenue for a total loss of about \$790.
4/16	S1	Attempted Theft by False Pretenses	Between 4:30 PM and 5:30 PM, the victim received a telephone call from unknown suspect(s) claiming to represent Immigration and Customs Enforcement. The suspect(s) demanded the victim provide \$900 in the form of gift cards or risk arrest and deportation. The victim bought the cards, but ultimately did not supply the card numbers. The victim lives in Saratoga.
4/16	S2	Vehicle Burglary	Between 6:45 PM and 6:50 PM, unknown suspect(s) broke through the windows of two vehicles parked near Safeway in the Argonaut Shopping Center on Saratoga Sunnyvale Road and took two backpacks and a laptop for a total loss of about \$1,600.
4/16	S9	Non-Injury Collision	Occurred at 8:41 PM at Allendale Avenue and Theater Way.
4/17	S8	Possession and Transportation of Marijuana for Sales, Suspended DL ARREST	At 12:21 AM, deputies made contact with a motorist who was initially pushing his vehicle down the road in the area of Saratoga Avenue and Prospect Road for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect was an unlicensed Marijuana delivery driver and was in possession of and transporting Marijuana in the vehicle for the purpose of sales. Further investigation revealed the suspect had been driving the vehicle with a suspended driver's license. The suspect was cited and released.
4/19	S6	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 4:23 PM at Saratoga Avenue and Crestbook Drive.
4/21	S3	Non-Injury Collision, DUI ARREST	At 7:15 PM, deputies responded to a non-injury vehicle collision in the 18000 block of Prospect Road. An investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect driver for driving under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was booked into Main Jail.
4/22	S8	Possession of Dirk or Dagger and Drug Paraphernalia ARREST	At 9:20 PM, deputies responded to a suspicious person call at the Subacute Pediatric Center on Sousa Lane on report of a man in the facility after hours, with a knife. An investigation revealed the suspect was in possession of a concealed knife, in violation of the suspect's probation. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail. Further investigation revealed the suspect's friend, who was waiting in a vehicle outside and also in possession of a knife, was in possession of drug paraphernalia and had two outstanding warrants. That suspect was cited and released.
