5/28	S2	Theft by False Pretenses	Between 4/23 and 5/14, the suspect(s), an overseas private seller, claimed to have a designer brand sweatshirt for sale and sold it to the victim for about \$535, but the victim never received the sweatshirt, and instead received a baseball card valued at about \$2. The victim lives in Saratoga.
5/28	S1	Theft by False Pretenses	Between 5/18 and 5/24, unknown suspect(s) hacked the victim's computer, initiated computer malfunctions then a pop-up advertisement for computer repairs, and instructed the victim to provide gift card numbers for payment for repair services. The victim complied and provided gift card numbers via telephone for a total loss of about \$3,000 before learning it was a scam. The victim lives in Saratoga.
5/28	S8	Theft by Credit Card	On 5/24, unknown suspect(s) used the victim's credit card information to make a fraudulent purchase for a total loss of about \$748. The victim lives in Saratoga.
5/28	S6	Theft by Credit Card	Between 5:30 PM and 9:55 PM on 5/26, unknown suspect(s) took four credit cards from the victim's wallet, which was left unattended in a break room at the Montalvo Arts Center on Montalvo Road, and made fraudulent purchases at various retailers for an unknown total loss.
5/28	S2	Possession of Controlled Substance, Unlicensed Driver ARREST	At 11:08 PM, deputies were patrolling Prospect Road and made contact with the driver of a vehicle regarding a traffic violation after it came to a stop in the Bank of America parking lot on S. De Anza Boulevard. An investigation revealed the suspect driver was in possession of Methamphetamine and was driving without a valid license. The suspect was cited and released.
5/29	S7	DUI, Suspended DL ARREST	At 3:40 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Saratoga Avenue and Fruitvale Avenue for a traffic violation. An investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect driver for driving under the influence of alcohol while on probation for DUI, with a suspended driver's license. Although not DUI, the suspect was cited and released for the probation violation.
5/29	S1	Identity Theft	At 11:52 AM, the victim received information indicating unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to open an out of state utility service account. The victim cancelled the account and did not incur any financial loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.
5/29	S1	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 2:22 PM at Saratoga Sunnyvale Road and Blauer Drive.
5/30	S3	Petty Theft	Between 5:00 AM and 5:05 AM, unknown suspect(s) cut a lock and took a bicycle from a bike rack at Prospect High School on Prospect Road for a total loss of about \$250.

The vehicle had an approximate value of \$6,000.

The suspect(s) also stole a purse containing credit cards from the vehicle and used the credit cards to make fraudulent purchases in the amount of approximately \$1,555. The stolen vehicle had an approximate value of \$27,000.
