6/18	S6	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 10:42 AM at Mendelsohn Lane and Piedmont Road.
6/18	S2	Commercial Burglary	Between 8:10 PM and 8:20 PM, the suspect(s) entered Safeway in the Argonaut Shopping Center on Saratoga Sunnyvale Road and loaded a shopping cart with more than approximately \$3,000 worth of alcoholic beverages before running out of the store and fleeing the scene in a waiting vehicle without paying for the merchandise. The suspect(s) are unknown and at large.
6/19	S8	Mail Theft	Sometime between 6/16 and 6/19, unknown suspect(s) took mail from the mailbox of a residence in the 18000 block of Devon Avenue for an unknown total loss.
6/20	S3	Non-Injury Collision	Occurred at 9:09 AM at Prospect Road and Scully Avenue.
6/22	S7	Construction without Permit	Between 5/31 and 6/22, the suspect began demolition of the suspect's residence in the 13000 block of Fortuna Court without first obtaining a permit. The complaint will be forwarded to the City's building division for investigation.

6/22	S8	Grand Theft	Between 4:40 PM and 4:50 PM, unknown suspect(s) took a cellular phone left unattended on a counter at the Mobil gas station on Saratoga Avenue for a total loss of about \$1,046.

The pursuit was terminated in the interest of public safety and the suspect is unknown and at large.

6/24	S3	Vandalism, Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance ARREST	At 9:59 PM, deputies responded to a disturbance call at a residence in the 19000 block of Brookview Drive. An investigation revealed two suspects damaged a window shutter, coffee pot and miscellaneous food items and were under the influence of a controlled substance, in violation of the terms of each suspect's probation grants. The total amount of damage was about \$1,500. Both suspects were arrested and booked into Main Jail.
