7/2	S3	Theft by False Pretenses	Between 11:14 AM and 5:30 PM, unknown suspect(s) telephoned the victim, claimed to work for Apple and alleged the victim's Apple account had been hacked. The suspect(s), who appeared to be calling from a legitimate Apple phone number, told the victim that assistance could be provided if the victim paid money in the form of gift cards. The victim complied for a total loss of about \$3,000. The victim lives in Saratoga.
7/2	S2	Identity Theft	At 3:00 PM, the victim received information indicating unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to open a postal service account. The victim immediately cancelled the account upon receiving this information and did not incur any financial loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.
7/3	S3	Check Fraud and Forgery	Sometime between 6/25 and 7/3, unknown suspect(s) forged a fraudulent check using the victim's information and withdrew money from the victim's checking account for a total loss of about \$10,000. The victim lives in Saratoga.
7/3	S8	Reckless Evading, Suspended DL	At 9:37 AM, deputies attempted to stop a motorist at Saratoga Avenue and Bucknall Avenue for speeding, but the suspect driver did not yield and recklessly evaded. An investigation revealed the suspect was also driving with a suspended driver's license. The suspect is known and at large.
7/3	S5	Non-Injury Collision	Occurred at 4:19 PM at Big Basin Way and 3 rd Street.
7/3	S2	Attempted Residential Burglary	At 9:31 PM, unknown suspect(s) attempted to enter a residence in the 12000 block of Marilla Drive through a bathroom window, but the suspect(s) ran off when the victim shouted at them and did not gain entry.
7/4	S7	Possession of Controlled Substances and Drug Paraphernalia ARREST	At 1:49 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Quito Road and Allendale Avenue for traffic violations. An investigation revealed two suspect passengers were in possession of Clonazepam, Methamphetamine, Oxycodone and two Methamphetamine pipes. Both suspects were cited and released.
7/5	S8	Commercial Burglary	Between 8:00 PM on 7/3 and 6:00 PM on 7/5, unknown suspect(s) entered Lynn Sally Hair Salon on Cox Avenue by prying a rear door open and took hair products for a total loss of about \$400.
7/7	S3	Attempted Residential Burglary	At 3:44 AM, unknown suspect(s) rang the doorbell of a residence in the 18000 block of Westview Drive, and when the victim resident did not answer the door, the suspect(s) attempted to kick it in. The suspect(s) ran off to a waiting vehicle without gaining entry after the victim yelled at them.
7/8	S3	DUI ARREST	At 1:55 AM, deputies were patrolling the area of Prospect Road and Lawrence Expressway when a motorist was observed driving without headlights. Deputies stopped the motorist and an investigation revealed the suspect driver was driving under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
