8/27	S9	DUI, Non-Injury Collision	At 5:50 PM, deputies responded to a solo-vehicle non-injury collision at Quito Road and Avon Lane where the suspect vehicle crashed into an electrical pole. An investigation revealed the suspect driver was driving under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was medically released and the case will be submitted to the District Attorney's Office for warrant issuance.
8/28	S9	Criminal Threats, Assault with Deadly Weapon, Negligent Discharge of Firearm, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Controlled Substances for Sales ARREST	At 1:48 PM, deputies responded to a disturbance call involving a weapon in the 18000 block of Marshall Lane. An investigation revealed the victim and suspect got into an argument whereby the suspect brandished and negligently discharged a firearm after making criminal threats towards the victim. The suspect fled the scene in a vehicle with another subject and was subsequently stopped. Further investigation revealed the suspect was in possession of Marijuana and Methamphetamine for sales and the suspect passenger was also in possession of Methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. Both suspects were arrested and booked into Main Jail.
8/29	S5	Stolen Vehicle	Between 3:00 AM and 9:00 AM, unknown suspect(s) stole a vehicle parked in the 14000 block of Oak Street. The vehicle was unlocked and the key was left inside. The vehicle, which had tools and work equipment valued at about \$2,589 stored in it, was valued at approximately \$4,000.
