9/3	S8	Identity Theft	On 8/22, the victims discovered unknown suspect(s) used the victims' personal information to access their bank accounts and made fraudulent payments to an unknown credit card account for a total loss of about \$28,000. The victims live in Saratoga.
9/3	S6	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 1:25 PM at Mendelsohn Lane and Bonnie Brae Lane.
9/4	S2	Ignition Interlock Device Required, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia ARREST	At 3:00 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Atrium Drive and Prospect Road for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect driver and passenger were both on probation and had outstanding warrants. Further investigation revealed the suspect driver was driving a vehicle without an ignition interlock device as required by court order and was in possession of drug paraphernalia, both offenses in violation of the suspect's probation terms. The passenger was released at the scene and the suspect driver was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
9/4	S8	Recovered Stolen Vehicle	At 12:00 PM, deputies recovered a vehicle, previously stolen from San Jose, in the 18000 block of Vanderbilt Drive. The suspect(s) are unknown and at large.
9/5	S9	Theft by False Pretenses	Between 7/5 and 9/5, the victim contacted a business online to be a secret shopper and was sent a fraudulent cashier's check. The victim deposited the check into a personal bank account, purchased 25 gift cards, provided the gift card numbers to the unknown suspect(s) and was told the balance of funds left was for the victim's service of writing secret shopper reviews. The check bounced for a total loss of about \$2,500. The victim lives in Saratoga.
9/5	S2	Petty Theft	Between 6:45 PM on 9/4 and 7:00 AM on 9/5, unknown suspect(s) entered an unlocked vehicle parked in the 18000 block of Harvest Lane and took two pairs of sunglasses for a total loss of about \$340.
9/6	S8	Vehicle Burglary, Residential Burglary	Between 2:25 AM and 3:00 AM, the suspects entered a dozen unlocked vehicles, and locked vehicles using unknown means, in the 18000 block of Montpere Way. The suspects took garage door remotes from two of the vehicles to access the garages at those residences. The suspects also took a firemen's jacket, pants and boots, in addition to cash, a bicycle, vehicle registration paperwork, and a vehicle owner's manual for a total loss of about \$3,000. The suspects are known and at large.
9/6	S8	Recovered Stolen Vehicle	At 3:19 AM, deputies recovered a vehicle, previously stolen from San Jose, at Weston and Alex Drives. The suspect(s) are unknown and at large.
9/6	S8	Commercial Burglary	Between 4:30 AM and 6:19 AM, unknown suspect(s) entered Saratoga Vision Center on Cox Avenue after breaking a window and took a pair of sunglasses for a total loss of about \$600.

An investigation revealed the suspect was unable to care for himself due to being under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
9/6	S7	Attempted Residential Burglary, Petty Theft	Between 4:15 PM and 4:30 PM, unknown suspect(s) entered the back yard of a residence in the 19000 block of Portos Drive and attempted to gain entry to the residence by cutting a window screen, but were scared off when it was realized that someone was home at the time. The suspect(s) took an unknown tool from the backyard, for an unknown total loss.
