10/1	S3	Identity Theft	Between 8/11 and 9/3, unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to access the victim's credit and debit card account information and fraudulently obtained money and goods for an unknown total loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.

An investigation revealed the suspect driver was driving a vehicle without a court ordered ignition interlock device, with expired registration. Further investigation revealed the suspect was also driving with a suspended driver's license. The suspect was cited and released.
