10/22	S2	Theft by False Pretense	Between 10/18 and 10/22, the victim contacted unknown suspect(s) interested in the sale of a video game console as posted for sale online. The victim wired money to the suspect(s), but never received the game console, and was unable to further contact the suspect(s) once the money was transferred for a total loss of about \$570. The victim lives in Saratoga.
10/22	S1	Vehicle Burglary	Between 5:40 AM and 5:45 AM, unknown suspect(s) entered two locked vehicles parked at a residence in the 20000 block of Carniel Avenue using unknown means. Both vehicles were searched through, but it is unknown if anything was taken, for an unknown total loss.
10/23	S4	Grand Theft	Between 10/17 and 10/23, the victim ordered and expected to receive a new cellular phone in the mail at the victim's residence in the 14000 block of Elva Avenue. The victim received the package container, but not the phone for a total loss of about \$1,000.
10/24	S4	Identity Theft	Between 1/1/17 and 10/24/18, unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to obtain a cellular phone service account and to apply for multiple credit accounts for an unknown total loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.
10/24	S4	Mail Theft, Theft by Credit Card	Between 1:00 PM on 10/22 and 2:50 PM on 10/24, unknown suspect(s) took mail from the mailbox of a residence in the 14000 block of Saratoga Hills Road. In the mail, was a newly issued credit card, which the suspect(s) used to make a fraudulent purchase for a total loss of about \$402.
10/24	S3	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 2:35 PM at Prospect Road and Lawrence Expressway.
10/24	S1	Assault and Battery	Around 3:00 PM, the victim and suspect got into a fight in the area of Beauchamps Court and Beauchamps Lane, whereby the victim alleges the suspect threw the victim to the ground causing injury. The suspect is known and at large.
10/25	S6	Theft by False Pretenses	Between 8/22 and 10/25, the victim communicated electronically with unknown suspect(s) met on a dating website. The suspect(s) claimed money was needed for taxes and to return to the United States from an overseas business trip and convinced the victim to wire money for a total loss of about \$150,000. The victim lives in Saratoga.
10/25	S2	Commercial Burglary	Between 6:45 PM on 10/24 and 6:00 AM on 10/25, unknown suspect(s) entered a residential construction site in the 13000 block of Glen Brae Drive by cutting a lock to a fence surrounding the property and entering through the open front doors. The suspect(s) took an assortment of construction equipment, materials and tools for a total loss of about \$4,802.

10/26	S4	Vandalism ARREST	Between 10:00 PM on 10/25 and 6:00 AM on 10/26, the suspect spray painted the driveway and vehicle at the victim's residence in the 21000 block of Congress Hall Lane, in addition to gates, landscape walls and mailboxes of other residences on the same block. Follow-up investigation revealed the same suspect also spray painted street signs in the area of Pierce and Mt. Eden Roads. The suspect was arrested at his residence in Saratoga and booked into Main Jail.

An investigation revealed the suspect driver was driving with a suspended driver's license, with an open container of alcohol, in a vehicle without an ignition interlock device as required per court order. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
