11/5	S2	Theft by False Pretenses	Between sometime in 2012 and 7/2018, the victim gave the suspect money under the guise of a Las Vegas casino investment. Over the years, the victim gave the suspect additional capital under the guise of business expenditures for a total loss of about \$300,000. The suspect is known and at large. The victim lives in Saratoga.
11/5	S4	Identity Theft	In 2015, the suspect(s) stole and cashed the victim's IRS return check, using the victim's personal information, for a total loss of about \$8,120. The suspect(s) are unknown and at large. The victim lives in Saratoga.
11/5	S9	Computer Fraud	Between 9/17 and 10/24, unknown suspect(s) hacked into the victim's social media and email accounts then launched a farcical derogatory informational campaign in the victim's name. The victim lives in Saratoga.
11/5	S2	Petty Theft	On 9/27, the victim discovered unknown suspect(s) entered the backyard of a residence in the 20000 block of Kilbride Drive and stole a welding settling tank for a total loss of about \$600.
11/5	S8	Theft by False Pretenses	Between 10/12 and 11/5, unknown suspect(s) emailed the victim about fraudulent charges on the victim's music subscription account. The suspect(s) instructed the victim to purchase gift cards from various locations and supply the serial numbers on the cards in order to catch the hackers. The victim complied for a total loss of about \$3,100. The victim lives in Saratoga.
11/5	S6	DUI While on Probation, Suspended DL, Open Container ARREST	At 12:47 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Saratoga and Fruitvale Avenues for traffic violations. An investigation revealed the suspect driver was driving under the influence of alcohol while on probation for a prior DUI conviction, and was driving with a suspended driver's license. Further investigation revealed the suspect passenger was in possession of an open alcohol container in the vehicle. Both suspects were cited and released.
11/5	S3	Commercial Burglary	At 12:53 PM, unknown suspect(s) entered a YMCA building on Titus Avenue by breaking a lock box open to access the building's key therein. The suspect(s) searched the building, but nothing was taken from the premises.
11/5	S4	Identity Theft	At 2:58 PM, unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to access the victim's savings account and withdrew money for a total loss of about \$472,000. The victim lives in Saratoga.
11/6	S9	Residential Burglary	Between 6:55 AM and 7:00 AM, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 13000 block of Ravenwood Drive through an unlocked window. The suspect(s) quickly fled the scene upon realizing a victim resident was home at the time. It is unknown if anything was taken from the residence.
