Meanwhile, deputies located a possible getaway driver near the scene and attempted to make contact with the suspect occupant inside the vehicle, but the suspect fled from deputies and recklessly evaded until reaching a dead end. The suspect driver then abandoned the vehicle and fled on foot. Burglary tools were found inside the suspect vehicle. The suspects are unknown and at large.
12/11	S3	DUI ARREST	At 11:27 PM, deputies stopped a motorist at Saratoga Avenue and Bellgrove Circle for a traffic violation. An investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect driver for driving under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was booked into Main Jail.
