*P3a. Description: (Describe resource and its major elements, include design, material, condition, alterations, size, setting, and boundaries)

This one-and-one-half-story shingled Craftsman-era house sits in a wooded setting that almost entirely screens it from the public right-of-way. The side-gabled house features a shed-dormer, unpainted siding, and original wood windows. According to previous records, alterations and additions to the original structure were well integrated into the original design. The house and garage originally had copper roofs; the roof of the house has been replaced but the copper roof of the garage remains. Major alterations and additions include a library and deck off the dining room added in 1965, conversion of a screened porch to an office in 1970, and a "Great Hall" and master bedroom with deck on the second floor added in 1980. The property also contains a working miniature railroad including a train station, locomotive and a section of track that circles the house. An amphitheatre overlooking Saratoga Creek is used for dramatic presentations.




